



Step #1

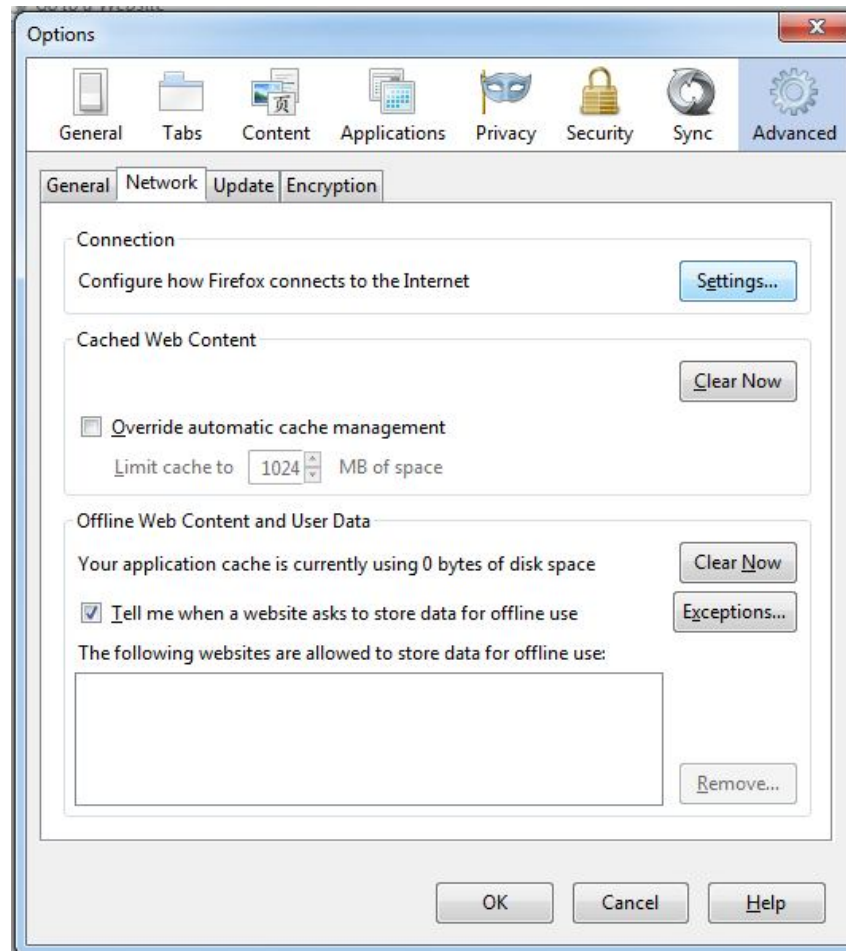

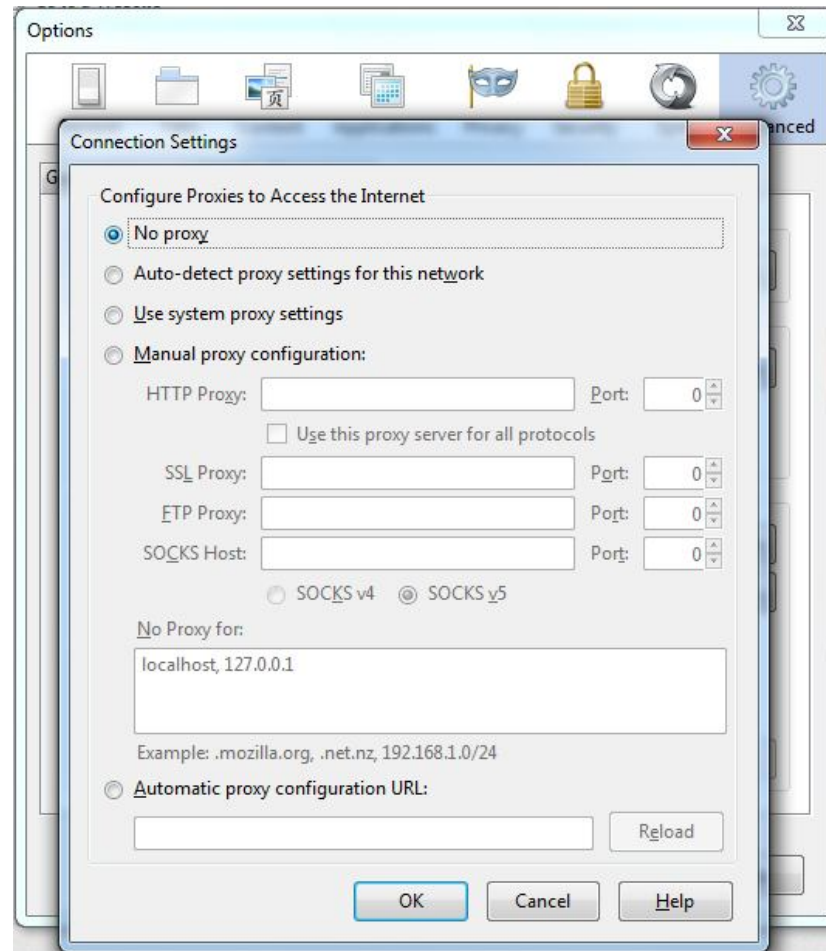
Select the "Advanced" tab.
